We offer our largest range of plants in containers from September. This is the best time to plant due to the soil being warm and generally moist which allows the new roots to establish quickly and easily before the colder winter months. Our bare-root range is available in December and is very limited so be sure to reserve your requirements in advance.

There is a handy guide to rootstocks, pollination groups etc. on the back page, but please do not hesitate to contact us for any additional advice you may require. We recommend using Rootgrow (mycorrhizal fungi) when planting your fruit for successful establishment, and don't forget tree stakes and ties to keep trees stable in the first few years.

APPLES: Container-Grown

AGM indicates that the plant has received an award in RHS Trials. Figures such as M27, MM106 etc. are rootstocks and this, together with tree forms and pollination groups, are explained on the back page. There are 2 **NEW** varieties (to us): 'Christmas Pippin' is an improved Cox-type and 'Rosette' has red flesh. A 'T' in the pollination column indicates that the variety needs **two** other pollinators (see back page). 'SF' is self-fertile: no pollinator needed.

These feature three varieties grafted onto one rootstock, giving a range of flavours and uses in the minimum space, and solving any pollination issues as well. Although the MM106 rootstock is used, the tree will not reach the height shown in the table on the back page, as the vigour is spread across all 3 varieties.

APPLES: Bare-Root

An excellent selection this year, with several new varieties (to us) and two cider apples. These are mostly one-year old 'maidens' or 'whips', but particularly ornate double-U cordons are also available. When you buy bare-root trees, make sure you at least heel the roots in on the day of purchase, and plant in their final position as soon as possible.

Kiwi Fruit: deliciosa varieties are the well-known 'hairy' kiwis. Jenny, Solissimo Renact and Solo are self-fertile. Hayward is the source of most commercial kiwi fruit, but is female and needs a male pollinator, e.g. Tomuri. Actinidia arguta is hardier, with smaller smooth fruits that can be eaten whole. Issai is self-fertile, Purpurna Sadowa is female and would need a male such as Weika for pollination.


