

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF A DIANTHUS NAME

This form, duly completed, should be sent to “**The International Dianthus Registrar, The Royal Horticultural Society's Garden, Wisley, Woking, Surrey, UK, GU23 6QB**”. Names already listed in the latest edition of *The International Dianthus Register* or in subsequent supplements should not be re-used and are not acceptable for registration. Names proposed should also be in accord with the latest edition of the *International Code of Nomenclature for Cultivated Plants*. Details of these publications may be obtained from the above address. Registration should take place before the name is published or disseminated in any other way.

There is no fee for the registration of a new cultivar name. A certificate of registration is available free of charge and will be supplied on request.

If possible please supply either dried, pressed petals and/or a good colour photograph (print, slide or electronic). These, together with the form, will constitute a definitive record or “standard portfolio” for future reference. If you supply any images please be sure to consider the copyright notice at the end of the form.
