The AGM criteria

Intended as a practical guide for the gardener, the AGM is awarded only to plants that are:

- excellent for ordinary use in appropriate conditions
- available in the trade
- of good constitution
- essentially stable in form and colour
- reasonably resistant to pests and diseases

AGM hardiness ratings

Each award includes a hardiness rating, which is an integral part of the AGM, and should be included in any citation of the award:

H1 requires heated glass

H2 requires unheated glass

H3 hardy outside in some regions; needs frost-free protection in winter

H4 hardy throughout British Isles

Descriptions

All descriptions have been drawn up by members of the RHS Fruit, Vegetable and Herb Committee, for the most part after trial.

SPINACH (*Spinacia oleracea*)

08 'Amazon' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–10. Vigorous plants that bulk well; leaves are large, round and a good glossy dark green

96 'Atlanta' (H3)

~ mid green large round leaves. Good cropper

08 'Barbados' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–10. Slow to bolt with attractive round, dark leaves and upright habit

02 'Campania' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Quick-maturing, with mid to dark green leaves; large frame; stands well. Bulks up quickly. Resistant to mildew races 1–5 and 7. Reconfirmed after trial 2008

02 'Emilia' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Very uniform plants, with upright habit and good dark green colour; slightly blistered (semi-Savoy) leaves. Resistant to mildew races 1–10. Reconfirmed after trial 2007 and 2008

07 'Fiorano' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–10. Upright habit; smooth, round-edged leaves are a good dark green. Reconfirmed after trial 2008

02 'Grodane' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Smooth, bright, mid to dark green leaves with slight blistering. Vigorous plants producing a bulky crop

08 'Hector' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. High yield of round, dark green leaves with a good flavour

07 'Lazio' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–10. Very reliable cultivar with a high yield and upright habit. Smooth, dark green very rounded leaves have a good

flavour. Bulks well. Widely grown in the trade for baby-leaf production. Reconfirmed after trial 2008

00 'Matador' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Thick, dark green, upright leaf

96 'Mazurka' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Round, dark green leaf. Useful crop; stands well before bolting. Reconfirmed after trial 2000

00 'Medania' (H3)

~ open pollinated; resistant to mildew races 1 and 3. Good yield from slower growing plants that are slow to bolt. Slightly blistered, large round leaves. Reconfirmed after trial 2008

07 'Mikado' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–4. New slow-bolting, oriental type with glossy, mid green, pointed leaves with long petioles. Vigorous and high yielding with good flavour. Bulks well; reconfirmed after trial 2008. May also be listed as 'Oriente'

96 'Monnopa' (H3)

~ upright leaf habit. Round, pale green leaves and a good crop

00 'Palco' (H3)

~ late; mid green, upright leaf

08 'Rhino' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–7. Uniform crop of dark green, smooth, rounded leaves. Plants are vigorous and bulk well

02 'Scenic' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Large, bright, prostrate mid green leaves. High-yielding, with mid season maturity. Suitable for 'cut and come again'. Reconfirmed after trial 2007

96 'Space' (H3)

~ F1 hybrid. Round, yellow-green, slightly puckered leaf. Later-maturing; stands well

~ F1 hybrid. Attractive, very dark green, blistered leaf. Tight hearts; good vigour. Fairly slow to mature. Would suit 'cut and come again' cropping</p> <p>96 'Spokane' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid. resistant to mildew races 1–3. Uniform, high-yielding crop of glossy, round, dark-green leaves; semi-rugose type; smaller-growing, with prostrate habit. Later-maturing; bulks well. Reconfirmed after trial 2000, 2002, 2007 and 2008</p> <p>00 'Tetona' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid. Vigorous, uniform plants with an upright habit,</p> | <p>producing a good yield of small, rounded, mid green leaves. Reconfirmed after trial 2007, 2008</p> <p>08 'Tirza' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–7. Heavy yield of mid green, smooth, rounded leaves. Vigorous, quite uniform plants</p> <p>07 'Tornado' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–7. Bulks well. Good dark green leaves with upright habit and a stronger flavour</p> <p>02 'Toscane' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid; resistant to mildew races 1–5 and 7. Good yield of uniform, very dark green leaves.</p> | <p>Relatively slow growing, so stands well. Useful for successional sowing from April to September. Reconfirmed after trial 2008</p> <p>93 'Triathlon' (H3-4)
~ F1 hybrid; early. Large, pointed, yellow-green leaves; strong-growing. An excellent crop</p> <p>02 'Trinidad' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid. Upright, vigorous, dark green shiny leaf. Slightly blistered. Later to mature; well-suited to autumn cropping</p> <p>08 'Veneto' (H3)
~ F1 hybrid. Slow to bolt; plants with good vigour, bulking well, producing pale to mid green, smooth leaves</p> |
