To identify which regions the speakers offer talks in please consult the 'Speakers by Region' document [on the RHS website](#). Many speakers are prepared to travel outside their regions, so pick a topic that your group is interested in and contact the relevant speaker.

Societies making use of the register are asked to contact speakers direct, ensuring they:

- Always confirm the booking in writing, agreeing all details in advance
- Check equipment is in good working order and suitable for the speaker's needs
- Arrange for somebody to meet the speaker, helping to unload equipment etc.
- Arrange for somebody to introduce the speaker and offer thanks afterwards
- Provide the speaker with refreshments for the duration of their visit
- Check whether fees quoted include travel and other expenses; these additional charges should be agreed with the speaker in advance
- Ensure any payment due is settled as soon as possible after the event
- Gather feedback from participants / feedback complaints (see below).
