

Terms and conditions of Auction sales:

Method of payment accepted: Valid Credit cards only.

Each lot shall be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer but must be paid for in full before legal titles to the goods passes to the buyer.

When the bid is accepted by the auctioneer's fall of the hammer, the successful bidder shall be deemed to be personally liable for the amounts of the accepted bids and payments shall be made to RHS Special Events (registered charity number 222879/SC038262).

The buyer of each lot shall give his/her full name and address and proof of identity to the RHS and shall purchase at the conclusion of the auction.

Neither the RHS, nor their servants, or agents are responsible for errors of description or for the authenticity of any lot for any misstatements as to any matter affecting the lot.

Neither the RHS nor their servants or any agents makes or gives nor has any of the employees of the RHS any authority to make or give any representation or warranty in relation to any lot and any implied conditions or warranties are excluded.

The RHS reserve the right to fix a reserve price for any lot, and may without giving any reason refuse to accept the bidding of any person.

In the case of a dispute as to any bid, the RHS may immediately put up the lot again at the last undisputed bid or withdraw the lot. Illustrations in the brochure are for general identification only.

The RHS sells the items as the beneficiary of the generosity of the donor.

The buyer shall pursue any claims in respect of the supply or failure to supply the product against the supplier of that product or service and not against the RHS.

Buyers should satisfy themselves prior to the auction as to the conditions of each lot.

Unless otherwise stated, travel to and from auction prize locations is not included in the lot.

Any statements by the RHS as to the lot is a statement of opinion only and every person should rely on their own judgment as to all matters affecting the lot.
