

THE INTERNATIONAL DAHLIA REGISTER (1969)

THIRTEENTH SUPPLEMENT

The following list contains the names of *Dahlia* cultivars registered between 1 January 2001 and 31 December 2001. It is issued as the *Thirteenth Supplement* to the *International Dahlia Register* (published in 1969 as a *Tentative Classified List and International Register of Dahlia Names*).

Raisers and introducers of new plants are urged to ensure that all their plants have been registered and are reminded that registration should take place before a plant is released or its name is mentioned in print. Registration concerns all named cultivars. Registration forms can be obtained from the International Dahlia Registrar, Royal Horticultural Society's Garden, Wisley, Woking, Surrey GU23 6QB, England.

In this list the cultivar name is preceded by an indication of the group to which the plant belongs, as defined in the 1969 Register, but which is repeated below. The line below begins with the parentage, when known, in parenthesis. The names of the raiser, introducer (where applicable) and registrant follow, together with the relevant dates (R = raiser, H = hybridizer, G = grown to first flower by, N = named by, I = introducer, REG = registrant). Where a date is given without a name (e.g. I & REG: 2001) it can be assumed that the individual or firm involved is that immediately preceding it, e.g. R: Fa. Gebr Verwer I & REG: 2001, in which Fa. Gebr Verwer raised the plant and then introduced it and registered the name in 2001. Details of flower diameter and stem height are included, where supplied by the registrant.

In this Supplement the International Cultivar Registration Authority has incorporated some of the large number of acceptable names which, for one reason or another, have never formally been sent for registration. These are given as e.g. REG (2001): International Cultivar Registration Authority. This catching up process will continue in succeeding Supplements.

Standards

This Supplement records the designation of Standards for some of the newly registered cultivars. Standards are a way to fix the application of a new name by reference to a particular example of a plant and provide a definitive record of its diagnostic characters. Standards may take the form of herbarium specimens, but can also be paintings or a photographic record, where this is more appropriate. All the Standards designated here are held in the Herbarium, RHS Garden, Wisley.

Note* An asterisk after the name of a variety defines that such variety has not thus far been registered with the International Cultivar Registration Authority.

GROUP CLASSIFICATION AND FORMATION

Group 1 - Single-flowered Dahlias

Single dahlias have blooms with a single outer ring of florets, which may overlap, the centre forming a disc.

Group 2 - Anemone-flowered Dahlias

Anemone-flowered dahlias have blooms with one or more outer rings of generally flattened ray florets surrounding a dense group of tubular florets, which are longer than the disc florets in Single dahlias, and showing no disc.

Group 3 - Collerette Dahlias

Collerette dahlias have blooms with a single outer ring of generally flat ray florets, which may overlap, with a ring of small florets (the Collar), the centre forming a disc.

Group 4 - Waterlily Dahlias

Waterlily dahlias have fully double blooms characterised by broad and generally sparse ray florets, which are straight or slightly involute along their length giving the flower a shallow appearance. The depth should be less than half the diameter of the bloom.

Group 5 - Decorative Dahlias

Decorative dahlias have fully double blooms showing no disc. The ray florets are generally broad, and flat and may be involute for no more than 75% of their length (longitudinal axis), or slightly twisted and usually bluntly pointed.

Group 6 - Ball Dahlias

Ball dahlias have fully double blooms, ball shaped or slightly flattened. The ray florets are blunt or rounded at the tips, with margins spirally arranged and involute for at least 75% of the length of the florets.

Group 7 - Pompon Dahlias

Pompon dahlias have blooms fully double spherical blooms of miniature size, with florets involute for the whole of their length (longitudinal axis).

Group 8 - Cactus Dahlias

Cactus dahlias have fully double blooms, the ray florets are usually pointed, the majority narrow and revolute for 50% or more of their length (longitudinal axis) and either straight or incurving.

Group 9 - Semi-Cactus Dahlias

Semi-Cactus dahlias have fully double blooms, the ray florets are usually pointed, and revolute for more than 25% of their length and less than 50% of their length (longitudinal axis), broad at base and either straight or incurving.

Group 10 -Miscellaneous Dahlias

Any dahlias which do not fall into one of the foregoing Groups e.g. Orchid-flowered dahlias, etc.

GROUPS AND SIZES

Certain Groups have been sub-divided and these, with their relative sizes, are as follows:

Waterlily Dahlias (Group 4), Decorative Dahlias (Group 5), Cactus Dahlias (Group 8) and Semi-Cactus Dahlias (Group 9)

- A** Giant-flowered – usually over 250mm (10in) in diameter.
- B** Large-flowered – usually between 200mm (8in) and 250mm (10in) in diameter.
- C** Medium-flowered – usually between 150mm (6in) and 200mm (8in) in diameter.
- D** Small-flowered – usually between 100mm (4in) and 150mm (6in) in diameter.
- E** Miniature-flowered – not usually exceeding 100mm (4in) in diameter.

Ball Dahlias (Group 6)

- A** Small Ball dahlias – usually between 100mm (4in) and 150mm (6in) in diameter.
- B** Miniature Ball dahlias – usually between 50mm (2in) and 100mm (4in) in diameter.

Pompon Dahlias (Group 7)

Pompon dahlias – not exceeding 50mm (2in) in diameter

(‘Los Angeles’* × un-named seedling) H (1996), G (1997), N (2001) & REG (2001): M. Robert I (2002): F. Combe-Laboissière. Fls 170mm wide, purple with white tips. Stem 1.1m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031326).

(‘Zuster Clarentine’* × un-named seedling) H (1989), G (1990), N (2001) & REG (2001): M. Robert I (2002): F. Combe-Laboissière. Fls 210mm wide, coral red with dark pink edges. Stem 1.4m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031328).

9(c) (fim) ‘Alauna Démon’

(Parentage unknown) R (1985), N (2001) & REG (2001): M. Robert I (2002): F. Combe-Laboissière. Fls 170mm wide, bright vermilion-red with lighter glow at base of florets. Stem 1.3m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031327).

8(c) ‘Alauna Flores’

(Parentage unknown) R (1995), N (2001) & REG (2001): M. Robert I (2002): F. Combe-Laboissière. Fls 180mm wide, deep rose. Stem 1.6m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031329).

9(c) ‘Alauna Philosophe’

(‘Suffolk Spectacular’ × un-named seedling) H (1998), G (1999), N (2001) & REG (2001): M. Robert I (2002): F. Combe-Laboissière. Fls 190mm wide, outer florets lavender with purple tips and inner florets white with purple tips. Stem 1.4m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031324).

8(b) ‘Alauna Pochette-Surprise’

(‘Los Angeles’* × un-named seedling) H (1985), G (1986), N (2001) & REG (2001): M. Robert I (2002): F. Combe-Laboissière. Fls 220mm wide, bright red with long white tips. Stem 1.4m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031325).

5(d) ‘Barbarry Brandy’

5(e) ‘Barbarry Buttercup’

5(e) 'Barbarry Marksman'

5(d) 'Barbarry Minstral'

5(d) 'Barbarry Orangetime'

5(e) 'Barbarry Polo'

6(b) 'Barbarry Wizard Ball'

5(c) 'Bargaly Blush'

(Sport from 'Scaur Swinton*') First propagated (2000), G (2000), N (2000) & REG (2001): R.J. Farley I (2002): Halls of Heddon. Fls 203mm wide, pink. Stem 1.22m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0027861).

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (1999) & REG (2001): L.G. Bloom I (2000): Connell's Dahlias. Fls 240mm wide, light bronze/yellow blends. Stem 1.35m.

10 'Blue Bayou'

(Parentage unknown) R (1997), N (1998) & REG (2001): E. van Dongen I (2000): Fa. E. & J. van Dongen. Fls 110mm wide, dark red (187A) shading to vivid reddish purple (78A) towards top of outer florets with dark red (59A) and deep purplish red (71A) tips to inner florets. Stem 0.9m.

6(b) 'Caer Urfa'

('Candy Cupid' × 'Hamari Rosé') H (1996), G (1997), N (1999), I (2000) & REG (2001): J. Clark. Fls 90mm wide, lavender. Stem 1m.

5(c) 'Campos Doctor Camp'

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (1999) & REG (2001): Dr R. Keesling I (2000): Campobella Dahlia Farm. Fls 180mm wide, pink. Stem 1.3m.

10 'Classic Summertime'

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (1999), I (2001) & REG (2001): Fa. Gebr Verwer. Fls 95mm wide, vivid greenish yellow (2A) to brilliant greenish yellow (2B) with vivid orange yellow (21A) centre. Stem 1m.

2 (anemone-flowered) 'Freya's Paso Doble'

(Parentage unknown) N (1993): D. Hewlett REG (2001): International Cultivar Registration Authority. Fls 100mm wide, with vivid greenish yellow (2A) to brilliant greenish yellow (2B) outer florets and vivid greenish yellow (2A) inner florets. Stem 1.4m. (Plant originally discovered flowering on the continent of Europe and named in error as 'Paso Doble': a name previously used and registered in 1961 for another style of dahlia - viz. medium decorative (5c).)

6(b) 'Hy Nugget'

5(d) 'Hy Plum'

4(d) 'Julia Catchpole'

('Tenovus' × 'Christopher Taylor') H (1995), G (1996), N (1996), I (2000) & REG (2001): K.E. Stock. Fls 110mm wide, soft salmon with slightly deeper shade to centre of inner florets. Stem 1.12m.

8(d) 'Karma Corona'

('Karma Sangria' × 'Witte-man's Best') H (1997), G (1998), N (1999), I (2001) & REG (2001): Fa. Gebr Verwer. Fls 130mm wide, strong reddish orange (42B) on brilliant greenish yellow (5A) base with brilliant greenish yellow (5A) towards top of florets. Stem 1m.

4(d) 'Karma Maarten Zwaan'

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (1999), I (2001) & REG (2001): Fa. Gebr Verwer. Fls 120mm wide, yellowish white (155B) on brilliant greenish yellow (1A) base. Stem 0.7m; light green stems a feature of the variety.

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (2000), I (2001) & REG (2001): Fa. H.M. van Paridon. Fls 130mm wide, brilliant greenish yellow (1B) with a slight vivid reddish orange (32A) glow above base of brilliant greenish yellow (1A). Stem 1-1.1m.

('Barbary Token' × 'David Digweed') H (1996), G (1997), N (2000), I (2001) & REG (2001): J. Clark. Fls 140mm wide, deep pink. Stem 1m.

5(c) 'Malvern Martha'

('Rossendale Luke' × un-named seedling) H (1996), G (1997), N (1998), I & REG (2001): B. Warriner. Fls 200mm wide, bronze. Stem 1.3m. Standard: colour slide supplied by registrant (WSY 0028786).

10 (star-flowered) 'Marie Schnugg'

(Parentage unknown) R (1971), N (1972) & I (1973): T. McNulty REG (2001): T.E. McLelland. Fls 25mm wide, vivid red (45B) with slightly paler vivid red (46B) with a hint of magenta to outer florets; vivid yellow (17B) inner florets. Stem 1.3m. An attractive and unusual style of flower.

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (1999), I (2001) & REG (2001): Fa. Gebr Verwer. Fls 130mm wide, vivid greenish yellow (2A) shading to deep purplish pink (55A) and strong purplish pink (55B) towards top of florets. Stem 0.7m.

(Parentage unknown) R (1997) & N (1998): P.R. Mingus I (2001): Mingus Dahlias REG (2001): International Cultivar Registration Authority. Fls 160mm wide, orange and yellow blends. Stem 1.3m.

8(c) 'Mingus Laura'

(Parentage unknown) R (1997) & N (1998): P.R. Mingus I (2001): Mingus Dahlias REG (2001): International Cultivar Registration Authority. Fls 172mm wide, red. Stem 1.3m.

9(c) 'Mingus Louis'

(Parentage unknown) R (1997) & N (1998): P.R. Mingus I (2001): Mingus Dahlias REG (2001): International Cultivar Registration Authority. Fls 170mm wide, lavender. Stem 1.3m.

9(c) 'Mingus Michealea'

(Parentage unknown) R (1998), N (2000), I (2001) & REG (2001): L.J.P. & P.M.H. van der Vlugt. Fls 120mm wide, strong purplish red (67A) shading to vivid reddish purple (74B) and light purple (75A) towards top of florets. Stem 1m.

(Seed from 'L.A.T.E.') H (1999), G (2000), I (2002) & REG (2001): J.R.G. Dahlias N (2001): J.R. Gott. Fls 100mm wide, pink outer florets with pink to yellow blends inner florets. Stem 1.37m. Standard: colour image supplied by registrant (WSY 0028788).

Fls 110mm wide, strong reddish purple (70B) and vivid purplish red (67B) stripes. Stem 0.42m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0029181).

(Parentage unknown) R (1992), N (2001) & REG (2001): W.H. Maritz I (2002): J.T. Dahlias. Fls 225mm wide, purple with lavender (dark blend). Stem 1.5m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031592).

(Parentage unknown) R (1993), N (1994) & REG (2001): W.H. Maritz I (2002): J.T. Dahlias. Fls 250mm wide, dark pink. Stem 1.5m. Standard: colour print supplied by registrant (WSY 0031250).

5(b) 'Penhill Rosy Morn'

(Parentage unknown) R (1996), N (1996) & REG (2001): W.H. Maritz I (2002): J.T. Dahlias. Fls 250mm wide, rose pink. Stem 1.5m.

This plant was originally supplied to Bridgemere Nurseries (UK) from The Netherlands in error for another cultivar and was believed at the time to be an unnamed seedling. It was named ‘Moonfire’ by Chris Sanders of Bridgemere and has achieved wide circulation under this name. Subsequently Mr Sanders saw it growing in a Dutch trial ground labelled ‘Sunshine’. The International Dahlia Register has a record of three uses of the name ‘Sunshine’, all with inadequate data, and despite extensive enquiries it has not been possible unequivocally to tie up the Bridgemere plant with any of these or to establish which of the three previous uses has priority.

The plant has not been supplied to any other outlet under the name ‘Sunshine’ and the ICRA proposes to sanction the use of the epithet ‘Moonfire’ for this plant.
