The garden, designed by Dan Hartley and built by Outdoor Living Gardens, harmoniously integrates Dawn's sculptures into the natural landscape, offering visitors a sanctuary for the soul amidst the beauty of rockscape, water rill, and charred timber, sourced sustainably from British suppliers.
