A mountainous, well-watered island like Grenada is bound to have many waterfalls throughout its one hundred and thirtythree square miles. But the most recently discovered one is unique Golden Falls.

Only this waterfall has two cascades of water next to each other. This geothermal effect is caused by Grenada's origin. Although it has no active volcanoes, not far below the surface is some areas, where heat from the earth's core leaks out, warming the waters of some of its streams. In addition, the sulphurous nature of the volcanic formation colours the water yellow, so it was named 'Golden Falls'. It is truly a natural wonder left alone to be enjoyed.
