vegetables. Do you know what this is called? What part of the plant is it?	Illustrate and handwrite or use IT and print out.
<ul> <li>Provide opportunities for children to handle and smell fruit/vegetables and to describe them by talking, drawing, labelling and tasting where</li> </ul>	Take weekly photo with digital camera to show progress of growth.  Record in a diary printing out photos to add illustration.
