# Discovering Trees

## TREE IDENTIFICATION

Curricular Links: Science and Numeracy

How long will it take? As long as you like!

# What do we need to bring?

Pictures of tree leaves or bark pictures (The RHS shop has some bark postcards from trees at RHS Garden Wisley). The Woodland Trust has identification sheets – but please check which trees are available at RHS Garden Wisley or use laminated, pressed real leaves collected during your pre-visit. (Please only collect leaves from the ground for this).

#### How do we do it?

Use the pictures or the sheets and as small groups try to match the trees to the pictures.

# Where can we do it?

Anywhere in the garden but it might be best to choose one area e.g. Battleston Hill, the Pinetum or the Arboretum.

## When is the best time?

Summer or early autumn for leaf identification or autumn/winter for bark only.

Who will it work best with? Years 2 – 6.





Make tree dominoes using real or drawn leaves; make a tree key (years 5-6).
