


RHS Garden Bridgewater - Paradise Garden

Designed by Tom Stuart-Smith to offer an escape from the world. It will be primarily a flower garden with large glasshouses rebuilt along the central section of the south facing wall of the Weston Walled Garden. The centre of the garden will have a square lily pond fed by two rills emanating from either end. An inspirational blend of Mediterranean climate zone and Asiatic plantings will bring the inner garden to life, whilst new glasshouses will allow plants to be grown throughout the seasons.




Chico Bench, with back and arm rests

Conditions of Bench Sponsorship – RHS Garden Bridgewater

Thank you for your sponsorship of a bench at RHS Garden Bridgewater. Your support for the creation of RHS Garden Bridgewater is gratefully acknowledged and we hope that you enjoy many happy visits to the Garden to see your sponsored bench in place, when the Garden is open, May 2021.

Please note the following important conditions, and sign and return a copy of the agreement with your donation. If you have any queries, please contact us before confirming your donation.

Sponsorship

Please note that your donation will go towards the purchase of benches at Bridgewater, plus all associated elements including delivery, installation, fixtures and fittings, hard-standing/base (as required depending on the nature of the ground at the specific location), plaque and engraving. If any funds remain, these are used for maintenance and repair costs during the 10 year guaranteed period, and to support the maintenance and purchase of other benches, ad-hoc garden furniture, and to help maintain the Garden. You are giving a donation to RHS Garden Bridgewater.

Lifespan

- Benches have a guaranteed lifespan in Bridgewater for a minimum period of 10 years from the date of installation in the Garden. Please note that our benches are chosen for their quality of manufacture and durability and, therefore, many benches will have a longer lifespan than the minimum guaranteed.
- o If, after the initial 10-year period, a bench is deemed to be in good order it will remain in the Garden at the discretion of the Curator until its condition or aesthetic is no longer viable for a public space, at which point it will be retired from use and removed from the Garden. The Curator has responsibility for all decisions relating to the removal of benches from the Garden.
- Where the RHS has current contact details for the donor, the donor will be contacted and offered the bench for their own use. The cost of removing and transporting the bench to an alternative location will be the responsibility of the donor. The donor may be offered the opportunity to fund a replacement bench at the discretion of the Curator.
- Benches form a natural part of the Garden and will weather over time. The seats may not be cleaned, varnished or painted after installation and sponsors may not attempt to undertake maintenance themselves.

Specification

Bench specifications and designs are in line with the look and feel of the specific garden area in which they are located. We have tried to give as full a description as possible with information supplied from the manufacturers. However please note that the actual bench may differ from our descriptions given or vary from the images shown.

Location and repair

- Occasionally benches may need to be relocated within the Garden due to changes in garden designs or new developments. We are unable to guarantee that a bench will remain in the same location for the duration of its lifespan in the Garden.
- Periodically benches may be temporarily removed from the Garden for minor repairs. We are not able to inform donors when benches are removed temporarily for this purpose. We will endeavour to maintain all benches to a high standard.

Plaque and Inscription

- The plaque will display your chosen names and dates (if desired) and an inscription, consisting of a maximum of 10 words.
- It is not possible to accommodate amendments or additions to the plaque or to add additional plaques to a bench.
