## PLANT LABELS

The plants at Rosemoor are labelled with their botanical (Latin) names. We do not use common names for a number of reasons. Common names are not standardised or regulated, and different common names may be used in different areas: in some cases the same common name may be used for more than one plant. The botanical (Latin) names of plants are governed by internationally agreed rules. They are unique to each plant, which makes it possible for these names to be understood by everyone, whatever language they speak.




