

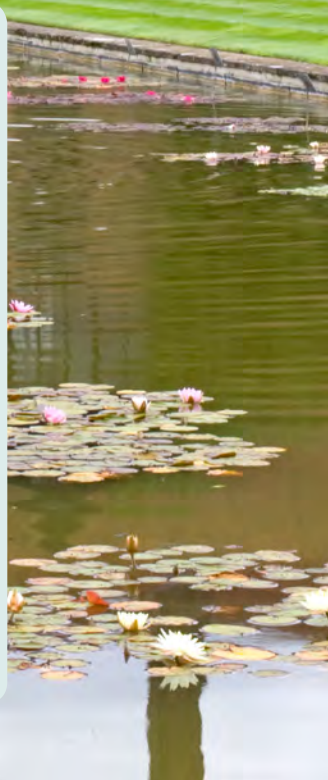


Garden highlights

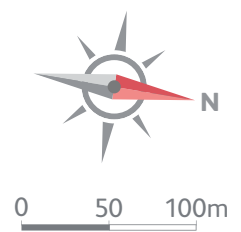


Visitor information
