How to make a bee watering station

Bee watering stations are perfect feeders to help bees collect water. It is an ideal area for bees to rest and provides lower risk of bees drowning.

1

Find an old flower pot and saucer, turn upside down to decorate the outside of your pot.



2

Place the saucer on top of the upside down pot.



3

Put some stones in the saucer and add a little water. Make sure the stones are arranged on top of each other at different levels above the water so the bees have a dry place to land and rest.



4

Display your bee watering station in your garden. Place it near bee friendly flowers and in a protected shady area.



Top Tip!

Make sure you change the water regularly so the bees have fresh water.
