Plum Establishment Problems

Container grown Plum trees should be planted either during the autumn before leaf-fall or during the spring when they are in full leaf. This will avoid establishment and die-back problems. For this reason container grown Plum trees will not be available from us during the winter. Please plant immediately after purchase during the autumn and do not leave in its container. It is also recommended to keep them on the drier side during the autumn.
