

**Plum Establishment Problems**

Container grown Plum trees should be planted either during the autumn before leaf-fall or during the spring when they are in full leaf. This will avoid establishment and die-back problems. For this reason container grown Plum trees will not be available from us during the winter. Please plant immediately after purchase during the autumn and do not leave in its container. It is also recommended to keep them on the drier side during the autumn.

<b>TREE FORMS</b>
<p><b>Bush:</b> Usual untrained free-standing 'tree shape'</p> <p><b>Standard:</b> Longer clear stem below the branches than bush forms</p> <p><b>Cordon:</b> Stem with short laterals, usually grown at 45°</p> <p><b>Espalier:</b> Trained with branches in a fan shape</p> <p><b>Fan:</b> Trained with branches in a fan shape</p> <p><b>Step over:</b> One horizontal branch, trained at low level</p> <p>Note: Cordons, Espaliers and Fans require training against a wall or fence</p>

<b>POLLINATION GROUPS</b>
<p>For a tree with a certain pollination group number (eg 3), a variety with a pollination group of the same number or one either side would be needed (in this case 2, 3 or 4).</p> <p>t = triploid</p> <p>Self-pollination or self-fertile is indicated by (sf)</p>
