



Garden Art is world famous as a supplier of rare and beautiful pieces of garden statuary, and for their collection of antique and contemporary garden items. A highlight of their stand at Chelsea this year (above) is a rare George IV Coade Stone Royal Coat Of Arms, stamped London 1820. H 140cm x W 250cm.

Their stand will also feature a fine pair of Italian terracotta statues of Apollo and Artemis 280 cm high (left); a pair of extremely rare late 19th Century marble benches; a life-size marble set of The Four Seasons, the Four Elements depicted in lead by JB White; limestone Flame finials; a pair of Greek revival vases one of two pairs exhibited at The Great Exhibition 1851 alongside a collection of rare Compton pottery, sundials, troughs and birdbaths.

Garden Art is situated in the two acre Barrs Yard site, just outside of Hungerford and 5 minutes off Junction 14 of the M4. They hold a wide and eclectic stock from the 15th Century to the current day sourced from across the UK and internationally. Urns, statuary, benches, tables and chairs alongside sundials, bird baths, fountains, stone troughs, staddle stones and arbours can all be viewed on the regularly updated website. They provide a complete service from sourcing garden antiques to advice and restoration services and delivery worldwide
