

Treat your senses to the abundant **Kitchen Garden** or follow the winding paths of the **Chinese Streamside Garden**.

Seasonal overview

Spring

As the seasons awaken, the garden transforms into a vibrant haven, with thousands of bulbs and plants bursting into bloom. In the spring, visitors can expect to see a kaleidoscope of colours, including daffodils, tulips, and bluebells, as well as sweet-scented flowers like hyacinths and lilies.

Summer

This 154-acre garden features a variety of themed gardens, including a Wellbeing Garden, Kitchen Garden, and extensive woodlands and meadows, all designed to inspire and delight visitors. With over 100,000 plants and flowers on display, the garden is a haven for nature lovers and photographers alike. During the summer months, the garden is particularly breathtaking, with blooming flowers and lush greenery creating a serene and idyllic atmosphere.

Autumn

In the autumn, the garden is particularly stunning, with the vibrant foliage of trees and shrubs. The garden's woodland area and Chinese Streamside garden are especially striking during this time, with leaves turning golden, crimson, and amber. Wander around the **Queen Mother's Lake**, a haven for visitors and wildlife alike, with its soft plantings, wildflower meadow and majestic trees. Then meander along the lush banks of **Streamside** through the heart of RHS Harlow Carr and venture into the historic **Bath House**. Don't miss the **Alpine House**, home to more than 2,000 plants, or the tranquil **Sandstone Rock Garden**. The vibrant **Sub Tropicana Garden** will transport you to exotic climes.

- View exuberant planting of herbaceous perennials, grasses, bulbs and shrubs, and a wealth of inspiring plant combinations
- Be amazed by lush moisture loving plants and eye-popping colours at the most iconic area of the garden - Streamside Garden

Seasonal overview

Spring

From waves of bright spring bulbs to enchanting rhododendrons in the woodland, there's so much to explore at RHS Harlow Carr. The season starts with over ¼ million bulbs including snowdrops, daffodils, bluebells, iris, crocus and grape hyacinths. Whilst in May, the rhododendrons – of all shapes and sizes and ranging from white to scarlet - are a must see.

Summer

The border and scented gardens are a particular highlight at this time of year with fabulous colour and fragrance to enjoy. Relax by the Queen Mother's Lake, discover botanical treasures in the Alpine House and see the vibrant Streamside primula candelabras and beautiful wildflower meadows.

Autumn

As the days shorten and cool, RHS Harlow Carr erupts with late perennials, grasses, and vibrant foliage. The woodland and arboretum are fabulous in the autumn, with rich golds, reds, and ambers. There's also plenty to see in the vegetable gardens and main borders.

Winter

Wrap up warm for a day at RHS Harlow Carr in the winter, with beautiful curated winter walks. Enjoy winter flowering trees, fragrant shrubs and a stunning mix of colourful stems and it's also a great time to bird spot from the bird hide.

A garden full of adventure

Set in the heart of rural Essex, RHS Garden Hyde Hall's glorious hilltop location offers sweeping panoramic views and wide-open skies. Visitors can pack a picnic blanket and come join us for some quality time in the garden.

Famed for dealing with challenging gardening in dry conditions, RHS Garden Hyde Hall is packed with dramatic colour, texture, and wonder. Explore the paths of **The Global Vegetable Garden** and then enjoy its produce in our cafes and restaurant. Alternatively take a stroll up **Clover Hill** to admire the wide views of the landscape beyond.

If your visitors are looking for a peaceful place to take in the stunning surroundings and native wildlife, they can make their way to the glorious Reservoir and Bird Hide to admire over 90 species of birds including swans, tufted ducks, and herons. In our quintessential **Hilltop Garden**, filled with fragrant roses, fishponds and colourful herbaceous borders, visitors can take a moment to treat their bare feet to our luscious green lawns.

Why visit?

- Be impressed by a variety of blooms in the colour-themed Herbaceous Borders resulting in a lively fiesta of colour throughout the year
- Meander through the woodland paths of the Birch Grove featuring five species of birch from Asia and North America
- Take a moment of quiet contemplation in the Queen Mother's Garden with its luscious tropical borders and shady spaces under mature trees
- View 400 species of drought-resistant plants originating from the Mediterranean, South Africa, South America, Australia, and California in the Dry Garden
- Delve into the Global Growth Vegetable Garden which will challenge perceptions of conventional kitchen gardens with its range of edible plants, from the everyday to the exotic
- Take in the heady scents of the charming Rose Garden and Rope Walk with its flamboyant collection of roses

Spring

As spring starts to emerge, the garden shows new signs of life, with golden daffodils as well as the colourful blooms of the many camellias and rhododendrons. Tulips, marsh marigolds and gorgeous malus and cherry tree blossom all come to life at this time of year.

Summer

Enjoy the sights and scents of the many beautiful English roses in the rose gardens, and don't miss the vibrant Herbaceous Border with its five colour themed bays.

Autumn

A blanket of brilliant autumn colour can be enjoyed thanks to RHS Hyde Hall's expansive woodland- with shades of gold, bronze and scarlet. The garden also has plenty of other areas of interest, with many late summer flowering perennials, crab apples and exceptional pumpkin displays making an autumnal visit full of seasonal delights.

Winter

There's still so much to enjoy in the garden over the winter and a sprinkling of frost can transform it entirely. Think crisp winter walks, with the lake reflecting a clear sky. Colour comes from hellebores, winter stems and viburnums.

RHS Garden Rosemoor is famous for its many 'garden rooms', with sections of the garden themed to celebrate the seasons in different ways with varying planting styles and designs, delivering interest all year round. Indulge in the scent of over 250 rose varieties in two dedicated gardens, at their fragrant peak in summer.

Experience a blaze of reds, oranges and yellows in the sizzling **Hot Garden** with layers of vibrant plants or unwind in the soothing pastels and blues of the **Cool Garden**, a tranquil oasis with a teardrop-shaped pond.

Discover trees from every continent of the Northern Hemisphere, see the **Devon Orchard** with rare heritage apple trees or be inspired by the range of delectable edibles grown onsite. You can even sample these onsite – the restaurant menus are seasonal and inspiring, making the most of the abundant produce harvested from the garden.

- Discover eight beautifully designed formal gardens all within easy access of the main Welcome Building – including two outstanding Rose Gardens, the famous Hot and Cool Gardens and a nostalgic potager garden, typical of Devon country gardens
- Explore the lake and streamside and enjoy the seasonal interest of rhododendrons, cornus and liquidambar alongside the lush growth and planting schemes
- Admire the heritage orchard, and fruit and vegetable garden displaying a wide array of produce grown using traditional and modern techniques

Spring

RHS Rosemoor in spring sees fabulous colour as the garden literally comes to life. Early in the season, the Upper Woodlands are full of wood anemones, and as the weeks progress, daffodils and fritillaries carpet the meadows, and rhododendrons and camellias bloom throughout the garden. May brings Japanese flowering cherries and other blossoms whilst the bluebells fill the Upper Woodlands.

Summer

RHS Rosemoor in early summer becomes an amazing fusion of colour and scent with Rose Gardens at their peak. The Wildflower Meadows get into a dramatic yellow and purple haze, and as summer progresses, the Hot Garden matures with spectacular colour. Enjoy the Mediterranean Garden with its classic scents and shades, and the tranquil Cool Garden designed by the award-winning Jo Thompson.

Autumn

Autumn brings harvest time to RHS Rosemoor, with plenty to see in the potager, fruit and vegetable gardens. As the season unfolds, expect to see vibrant Acer, fruits, berries and grasses, moving onto the rich golds, reds and oranges of autumn colour throughout the garden. Savour the last of the autumn sunshine in this beautiful setting.

Winter

As autumn leaves the valley you can still experience a wealth of colour, scent and texture in RHS Rosemoor's dedicated Winter Garden and enjoy their national collection of a delightful trail. Enjoy frost-sparkled walks, evergreens throughout the garden and vivid stem colour and textures.

The RHS Hilltop – The Home of Gardening Science is dedicated to inspiring the next generation of gardeners. Visitors can see the vital work being done to help future-proof our planet and learn all about the RHS' ground-breaking research. There's always time to discover fruit and veg of all shapes and sizes in the World Food Garden, sit and reflect in the Wellbeing Garden, or spot insects skimming the water's edge in the Wildlife Garden.

To awaken the senses, visitors can challenge themselves to race up **Battleston Hill**, breathe in the heady scents in the **Bowes-Lyon Rose Garden**, or gaze up in wonder in the tropical **Glasshouse**.

Spring

RHS Wisley is famous for its spring displays – huge collections of magnolias and rhododendrons bring colour to the woodland gardens, and hundreds of bulbs carpet the lawns and borders. The Alpine House always has something new to offer and Wisteria Walk becomes a tunnel of glorious purple racemes, complementing RHS Wisley's impressive collection of wisteria around the garden.

Summer

Summer highlights at RHS Wisley include the spectacular Bowes-Lyon Rose Garden - bursting with colour and scent- as well as the Mixed Borders, which are vast beds of colour, texture and form. Be sure not to miss The Exotic Garden home to lush tropical foliage and bold colours.

Autumn

Enjoy the acres of autumn colour from RHS Wisley's extensive tree collections, the autumn flowering crocus, and see how beautiful a garden can look when it is falling asleep for winter. Golds, oranges and reds adorn the landscape, while the Orchard is a tapestry of scent and colour with hundreds of apple varieties.

Winter

There is always something to see at RHS Wisley, and winter is no exception. The Winter Walk is a circular path around the lake which is planted with shrubs and trees for winter display, including scented plants and shrubs with colourful stems and leaves. Marvel at the century old conifers in the Pinetum and warm up in the Glasshouse where there is always something exotic to admire.






