5		One Pink or Red, three blooms, in one vase
6		One, any colour but not eligible for classes 3 to 5, three blooms, in one vase
7		One Lily-flowered, three blooms, in one vase
8		One Fringed, three blooms, in one vase
9		One Viridiflora, three blooms, in one vase
10		One Parrot, three blooms, in one vase
11		One Darwin, three blooms, in one vase
12		One Kaufmanniana, Greigii or Fosteriana, five blooms, in one vase
13 **		One Multi-headed cultivar, three STEMS in one vase
14 **		One Species, five blooms in one vase
15 **		One Species, one pot or pan of at least 5 bulbs in flower
