The following are the conifer Registrations received since the last Additions in the *Cultivar Registration Bulletin* 2020, RHS 2020. The abbreviations used are:

**Reg:** the registrant

**O:** the originator – the raiser or person who first noticed the merit of a spontaneous variant

**N:** the nominant or name-giver

**I:** the introducer, usually the business which first distributed the plant commercially

All descriptions and comments are essentially those of the registrants.

### CHAMAECYPARIS

#### ‘Caecilie’

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* cv.

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* × unknown

**O:** P. Jones (2010), **REG:** J. Harvey (2022)

Miniature, globose to bun-shaped, with dark green needles. Slow-growing <1.0cm/year; c. 15 × 15cm in 11 years.

#### ‘Narrator’

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* cv.

Sport from *C. obtusa* ‘Gracilis’, found growing at Marder’s Nursery, New York, USA

**O:** T. Marder (2016), **N:** T. Marder (2022), **REG:** Folly Tree Arboretum (2022)

Dwarf, globose. Dense, spiky growth, retaining juvenile awls. New growth has a glaucous whitish/purplish/bluish tone. Growing to 10cm/year to around 0.9 × 0.9m in 6 years

**Etymology:** the tree will be used to narrate a travelling, live puppet show that tells the horticultural histories and stories behind various plants

#### ‘Pete’

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* cv.

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* × unknown

**O:** P. Jones (2012), **REG:** J. Harvey (2022)

Miniature, globose, but with an open, layered look, with dark green needles. Slow-growing <1.0cm/year, c. 8.0 × 8.0cm in 10 years

#### ‘P.J.’s Gold’

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* cv.

*Chamaecyparis obtusa* × unknown

**O:** P. Jones (1996), **REG:** J. Harvey (2022)

Miniature, globose, needles, green, with yellow highlights on the midribs, the highlighting becoming almost white towards the stems. Slow-growing <1.0cm/year; c. 15 × 15cm in 11 years
