In the list below <u>R</u> = raiser, <u>H</u> = hybridiser, <u>G</u> = person who grew the plant to its first flowering, <u>S</u> = selected by, <u>N</u> = person naming the plant, <u>I</u> = introducer, <u>REG</u> = registrant.

Colour codes such as '85B' or '95C' refer to the RHS Colour Chart (1966, reprinted 1986 & 1995).

'Elizabeth Cook' cl. (Parentage unknown) <u>S</u> & <u>G</u>: W. A. Cook, 1991 <u>N</u>, <u>I</u> & <u>REG</u>: 1997. Stems short (1.0m). Spikes 65 - 70cm long, tapering to apex, with a few laterals of medium vigour. Fls semi-double, 60mm wide, pure white, with a pure white eye. Spurs 25mm long. Pedicels 85mm long.

'Franjo Sahin' (Un-named seedling \times 'Min') <u>H</u> (1992), & <u>N</u> (1997): D. McGlashan <u>G</u>: K. Sahin, 1994 <u>I</u> & <u>REG</u>: K. Sahin & D. McGlashan, 1997. Stems tall (2.05m). Lvs mid green. Spikes 1.1m, tapering to apex, with several strong laterals. Fls semi-double, 100mm wide, rosy mauve (light purple, 80D) shading to a deep rosy mauve (vivid violet, 87A) picotee edge; some dark pink infusion and central banding; eye dark brown (moderate reddish brown, 177A), prominent, striped with main floret colours in centre. Spurs 10 – 15mm long. Pedicels 90mm long.

'George Davies' cl. ('Fenella', selfed) <u>H</u> (1993) & <u>G</u> (1994): T. N. Murphy <u>N</u>, <u>I</u>, & <u>REG</u>: 1997. Stems medium (1.6 - 1.7m). Lvs mid green, larger than in 'Fenella'. Spikes 0.9 - 1.0m, tapering to apex, with just a few not very givorous laterals. Fls semi-double, 73 - 76mm wide, vivid purplish blue (99C) shading to strong blue (101B) in centre of floret, the petaloids thicker and more durable than in the parent, holding their colour better in the sun and standing up well to rain; eye dark brown. Spurs 28mm long. Pedicels 100mm long.

LILAC CONCERTO. Trade designation for 'Sakovio'.

'Sakovio' cl. (Un-named seedling (no. L17) × un-named seedling (no. 8307)) <u>H</u> (1987), <u>G</u> (1988), <u>N</u> (1992) & <u>I</u> (1993): A. Koen <u>REG</u>: 1997. Stems short (1.25m). Spikes 50 – 60cm long, tapering to apex, with very few laterals. Fls semi-double, 70mm wide, light purple (85B), with a creamy eye (with violet stripes and yellow hairs). Spurs 26mm long. Pedicels 40mm long.

Trade designation: LILAC CONCERTO

'Sheenagh Alice' cl. ('Min' × 'Tiddles') <u>H</u> (1992) & <u>N</u> (1997): D. McGlashan <u>G</u>: K. Sahin, 1993 <u>I</u> & <u>REG</u>: D. McGlashan & K. Sahin, 1997. Stems medium (1.95m). Spikes 1.02m, blunt at apex, with several long, strong laterals. Fls semi-double, 90mm wide, very pale purple (85D), edged light violet (88D); eye white, with some banding of pale violet. Spurs 8 – 10mm long. Pedicels 80mm long.
