In the list below \underline{R} = raiser, \underline{H} = hybridiser, \underline{G} = person who grew the plant to its first flowering, \underline{S} = selected by, \underline{N} = person naming the plant, \underline{I} = introducer, \underline{REG} = registrant.

'Blondie' cv.

(Selected pink seedling ($\stackrel{\bigcirc}{+}$) × 'Our Deb') \underline{H} (1996), \underline{G} (1997), \underline{N} (1999), \underline{I} (2000): J. H. Barrington REG: 2001.

Stems medium (1.55m). Spikes 72cm, tapering at apex, with a few laterals of medium vigour. Fls fully double, 80mm wide, rich creamy yellow with no eye; spurs 21mm long; pedicels 83mm long.

'Plagu Blue' cv. ('Imp' ($\stackrel{\frown}{}$) × 'Moody Blue') \underline{H} (1990) & \underline{G} (1991): K. Kunishi \underline{N} (1994) & \underline{I} (1995): Japan Tobacco Inc. \underline{REG} : K. Kunishi, 2001.

Stems short (1.48m). Lvs ciliate, dark green. Spikes 70cm, very lax, tapering slightly to apex, with 4-5 strong laterals. Fls single, 50mm wide, vivid purplish blue (99B), with a well-defined green spot near the tip on the outer surface; eye mainly vivid purplish blue (99B), with yellow hairs; spurs 13.8mm long; pedicels 83mm long. Belladonna. (Standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY0030176)).

'Plagu Light Purple' cv. (Sport from 'Plagu Blue') First propagated (1995), <u>N</u> (1997) & <u>I</u> (1998): Japan Tobacco Inc. REG: K. Kunishi, 2001.

Stems medium (1.5m). Lvs ciliate, dark green. Spikes 68cm, tapering slightly to apex, very lax, with 4-5 strong laterals. Fls single, 50mm wide, vivid violet (89B), with a well-defined green spot near the tip on the outer surface; eye mainly vivid violet (89B), with some yellow hairs; spurs 15mm long; pedicels 90mm long. Belladonna. (Standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY0030177)).

'Royal Ascot'cv. (Un-named pink seedling × un-named pink seedling hybrid). <u>H</u>: Dr S. Bassett, 1998 <u>G</u> (1989), <u>N</u> (1999) & <u>REG</u> (2001): L. J. P. Cain.

Stems medium (1.5m). Spikes c.1.0m, tapering to apex, with c.4 laterals. Fls stem-double, 75mm wide, pale pink, deepening to the outer edge; eye light brown. (Standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY0029674)).

'Walter Benjamin' cv. (Parentage unknown). <u>G</u> (1996) & <u>N</u>: H. Wilkins <u>I</u> & <u>REG</u>: Woodfield Bros, 2001.

Stems medium (1.5m). Spikes c.1.0m, tapering to apex, with c.6 vigorous laterals. Fls semi-double, 70mm wide, mid blue, with a prominent mid blue and black eye; spurs 40mm long; pedicels 90mm long. (First published in Woodfield Bros catalogue, 2001)
