

THE INTERNATIONAL DIANTHUS REGISTER (1983) & CHECKLIST

TWENTY-THIRD SUPPLEMENT

The following list contains the names of *Dianthus* cultivars registered between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2005.

Raisers and introducers of cultivars of *Dianthus* are urged to ensure that the names of all their plants have been registered and are reminded that registration should take place before a plant is released or the name is mentioned in print. Registration concerns all named cultivars. Registration forms can be obtained from the International Dianthus Registrar, 109 York Street, Cambridge CB1 2PZ, United Kingdom who will issue a certificate of registration on request. The format of entries follows a pattern first adopted in the Fifth Supplement. Following the classification and name of each new cultivar a statement regarding parentage or origin is given in parenthesis. The names of those involved in the raising, introduction and registration of the plant are then given, together with relevant dates (R = raiser, H = hybridizer, G = grown to first flower by, S = selected by, N = named by, I = introducer, REG = registrant, L = listed by). When a date is given after a colon and without a name (e.g. REG: 1987) it can be assumed that the individual or firm involved is that immediately preceding it, e.g. R (1982) & I (1983): A. Smith REG: 1984 implies that the plant was raised by A. Smith in 1982, introduced by him in 1983 and registered by him in 1984.

Perpetual carnations are listed, where known, as sprays or standards. The use of the latter should not be confused with the citation of nomenclatural standards which refer to individual herbarium specimens or images (slides, prints etc.) which have been selected as the definitive point of reference should any doubt arise about the plant to which the name concerned should be applied.

Colour references such as 128D are to the RHS Colour Chart (1966, 1986, 1995, 2001), those such as 730/3 refer to the Horticultural Colour Chart (1941). The descriptions are as full and consistent as information provided by the registrant and other sources allows. Any additional material would be welcomed by the Registrar.

This publication is styled both as a Register and Checklist. As such it contains not only the most recent new registrations, but details of other plants for which information is available even though their names are not formally registered. Some of these unregistered names would be unacceptable for registration as they contravene Articles in the *International Code of Nomenclature for Cultivated Plants* (2004). Where this is the case, the relevant Code Article is given.

(pf) ‘Acapulco’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 1999), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, deep red self; margins moderately and sharply toothed. Standard.

(pf) ACTIVA Trade designation for ‘Lonactiv’.

(b) ‘Adam James’

cv. (Un-named, pale pink seedling × ‘Pennine Pico’). H: C.S. Wilson (1991), G: C.S. Wilson (1992), N: Allwood Bros, I: Allwood Bros, REG: C.S. Wilson (2005). Fls double, 30mm wide, pink ground, mauve wire edge; margins entire; not scented. Lvs to 175mm long, silvery grey. Stems 22.5cm. (First published Allwood Bros cat., 1992. Etymology: named for the son of the current owners (2005) of Allwood Bros.)

(pf) AICHA Trade designation for ‘Lontienac’.

(pf) ALADIN Trade designation for ‘Klen02421’.

(pf) ‘Alegro’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen, N: P. Kooij & Zonen, I: P. Kooij & Zonen (1999). Fls fully double, mid pink self; margins shallowly toothed. Standard. (Unacceptable name (already in use, Art. 27.1), but accepted as part of an EU grant of PBR, so must be retained for this cultivar.)

(b) ‘Alessandro Russell’

cv. (‘Forest Glow’ × ‘Betty’s Joy’). H: P.W. Russell (2002), G: P.W. Russell (2003), N: P.W. Russell (2005), I: P.W. Russell (2005), REG: P.W. Russell (2005). Fls fully double, 75mm wide, light orange-yellow (22D), with deep pink (52B) markings; edges smooth; not scented. Very robust habit (1.1m under glass). (Etymology: named for the registrant’s first grandson.)

(pf) ALLIANCE Trade designation for ‘Koalic’.

(pf) ‘Amalfi’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: F. Sapia (pre- 1997), N: F. Sapia. Fls fully double, very pale pink ground, narrowly edged and with a few, short, well-defined marginal stripes and a few longer central stripes of purplish red; margins very shortly toothed. Standard.

(pf) AMORE Trade designation for ‘Kleremo’.

(p) amurensis ‘Andrey’

cv. (Selection from *amurensis*). S: M. Wickenden, N: M. Wickenden, I: M. Wickenden, REG: M. Wickenden (2005). Selected from seed originally collected on Rikord Island in the Amur Straits near Vladivostok. Fls single, large, mauve self. Stems 15cm. (Etymology: named after the Russian guide accompanying the registrant on his visit to Rikord Island. The ICRA is permitting the re-use of this epithet since the earlier use was merely a nineteenth century error for ‘Audrey’ (May).)

(p) ‘Anders Apollo’

cv. (‘Oakwood Romance’, open-pollinated). H: A.J. Derrick (2003), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls fully double, 35mm wide, deep purple self; margins toothed; not scented. Lvs ‘heavy, strap-like’, deep blue. Strong stems (to 35cm under glass).

(p) ‘Anders Aurora’

cv. (‘Anders Joto’, open-pollinated). H: A.J. Derrick (2003), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls double, with an open centre, 40mm wide, scarlet self; margins with only a few very shallow teeth; not scented. Stems 30cm (under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060685).)

(p) ‘Anders Emily Elizabeth’

cv. (‘Oakwood Candy’ (s) × ‘Oakwood Billy Boole’). H: A.J. Derrick (2003), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls fully double with a more-or-less open centre, 40mm wide, pink ground, very heavily flecked and dashed with crimson throughout; margins very shallowly toothed; not scented. Strong grower with numerous stems, to 30cm (under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060688). Etymology: named after a still-born daughter of a family friend.)

(p) ‘Anders Fay Seagrave’

cv. (‘Anders Tia’ (s) × ‘Welton Beauty’). H: A.J. Derrick (2003), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls single, 40mm wide, white ground, with a deep maroon eye and lacing (inner margin of lacing and outer edge of eye distinctly irregular); margins very shallowly toothed; not scented. Thin foliage. Stems tall (45cm under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060689). Etymology: named for the wife of a friend of the registrant.)

(pf) ‘Anders Huntsman’

cv. (‘Aicardi’ (s) × un-named crimson seedling). H: A.J. Derrick (2000), G: A.J. Derrick (2001), N: A.J. Derrick (2003), I: A.J. Derrick (2003), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls fully double, 90mm wide, scarlet self; margins shortly toothed; not scented. Strong, robust stems. Standard. (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060691). Etymology: an allusion to the colour of some huntsman’s jackets.)

(p) ‘Anders Jade’

cv. (‘Welton Star’, open-pollinated). H: A.J. Derrick (2001), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2002), I: A.J. Derrick (2005), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls single, 25mm wide, white ground, with a large red eye; margins of petals and outer rim of eye toothed; not scented. Thin foliage. Short stems (18cm under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060687). Etymology: named for the wife of a friend of the registrant.)

(pf) ‘Anders Kate Murray’

cv. (‘Anders Kath Phillips’ (s) × ‘Anders Sundance’). H: A.J. Derrick (2001), G: A.J. Derrick (2002), N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J.

Derrick (2005). Fls fully double, 80mm wide, very pale yellow ground, edged and heavily flecked with light crimson; margins entire or very shortly toothed; not scented. Standard. (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060690). Etymology: named for the mother of a friend of the registrant.)

(p) ‘Anders Lavender Girl’

cv. (Un-named seedling × un-named seedling). H: A.J. Derrick (2003), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls semi-double (with several shorter petals in the centre), 28mm wide, lavender self; margins with very shallow teeth; not scented. Lvs mid glaucous blue. Stems tall (35cm under glass). (Etymology: similar colour to (pf) ‘Lavender Lady’ but much smaller.)

(p) ‘Anders Ria’

cv. (‘Hilary Flett’, open-pollinated). H: A.J. Derrick (2003), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls double, but with an open centre, 30mm wide, crimson self; margins very shallowly toothed; not scented. Narrow foliage. Stems short to medium (25cm under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060686). Etymology: named for the wife of a friend of the registrant.)

(p) ‘Andrey’

See *amurensis* ‘Andrey’.

(pf) ARABELLA Trade designation for ‘Lonvata’.

(pf) ‘Arena’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 1999), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, white ground, with narrow red stripes (short around margins, longer down centre of petals); margins shortly toothed. Spray.

(pf) ‘Arony’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: ARO, Israel (pre- 1982), N: ARO, Israel. Fls fully double, vivid reddish orange (40A) self; margins toothed. Spray. Sometimes seen in error as ‘Aroni’. Trade designation: RONY, RONI. (Previously listed (as ‘Rony’) in Fourth Supplement (1987).)

(pf) ‘Art’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen, N: P. Kooij & Zonen, I: P. Kooij & Zonen (1999). Fls fully double, yellow ground, narrowly edged with very short dark red stripes and an occasional fleck of same colour; margins shortly toothed. Spray.

(pf) ARTEMIS Trade designation for ‘Klen01118’.

(pf) ATLANTIS Trade designation for ‘Klen02461’.

(pf) ‘Atletico’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc (pre- 1994), N: Barberet & Blanc. Fls fully double, white ground, with numerous, red, marginal stripes,

stripes varying from very short to long and very narrow to broad; margins very shortly toothed. Standard.

(pf) ATLETIC SCHUBERT Trade designation for 'Lonatlesch'.

(p) 'Audrey's Frilly'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: unknown (pre- 1994). Fls semi-double, 25-38mm wide, the central petals standing up at first, pure white ground, with a clear cut eye and lacing of dark red (187C); margins slightly toothed.

(pf) 'Augurio'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: F. Sapia (pre- 1998), N: F. Sapia. Fls fully double, white ground, very narrowly edged and with sparse narrow stripes and some speckling of red; margins shallowly toothed. Standard.

(pf) AVEIRO Trade designation for 'Lonaverio'.

(p) 'Avon Dasset'

cv. (Derived from the Highland Group (Highlands Hybrids)). G: M. Walker (pre- 1990), N: M. Walker, REG: Dasset Nurseries (2005). Fls single, 25-30mm wide, bright pink ground, with a deep red eye taking up at least 1/3 of each petal; margins very unevenly toothed and shallowly lobed; hardly scented. Lvs blue-green. Stems 20cm (under glass). Plants compact. June-July. (Nomenclatural standard: colour slide provided by registrant (WSY 0070233). Etymology: Avon Dasset is a village in Warwickshire where the plant was raised.)

(pf) 'Ballantyne'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 1997), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, greenish yellow self; margins toothed. Spray.

(pf) 'Báltico'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Di Giorgio (pre- 1999), I: Barberet & Blanc. Fls fully double, pure white self; margins irregularly and deeply toothed. Standard.

(pf) 'Baraugier'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Di Giorgio (pre- 2005), I: Barberet & Blanc. Fls fully double, pale orange ground, narrowly edged pinkish red with a very occasional stripe or fleck; margins shortly but sharply toothed. Standard. Trade designation: MADAME AUGIER

(p) 'Barbara Norton'

cv. (Parentage unknown). I: Stone House Cottage Nurseries (c 1987). Fls single, deep pink, with a maroon eye. Stems 15cm. (Given to them by a man from Herefordshire NCCPG who had raised it and named it after his wife.)

(p,a) barbatus 'Woodfall'

cv. (Parentage unknown). N: M. Wickenden (2005), I: M. Wickenden (2005), REG: M. Wickenden (2005). Fls single, maroon ground, with a large white eye. Stems 40cm. (Found in a garden called Woodfall, near Cally Gardens, Scotland.)

(pf) ‘Barbelen’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc, N: Barberet & Blanc, I: Barberet & Blanc (2005). Fls fully double, orange-yellow ground, edged and with short marginal striping and some flecks of red; margins toothed. Spray. Trade designation: BELEN

(pf) ‘Barberta’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc, N: Barberet & Blanc, I: Barberet & Blanc (2005). Fls fully double, mid pink self, margins not or very shallowly toothed. Standard. Trade designation: BERTA

(pf) ‘Barcandela’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc, N: Barberet & Blanc, I: Barberet & Blanc (2004). Fls fully double, pale yellow self; margins deeply toothed. Spray. Trade designation: CANDELA

(pf) ‘Barcelta’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc, N: Barberet & Blanc, I: Barberet & Blanc (2005). Fls fully double, greyed purple self; margins sharply toothed. Standard. Trade designation: CELTA

(pf) ‘Barebeca’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc, N: Barberet & Blanc, I: Barberet & Blanc (2004). Fls fully double, pale orange-yellow ground, edged and with numerous short marginal stripes and a few flecks of red; margins shortly toothed. Spray. Trade designation: REBECA

(pf) ‘Bareiko’

Syn. of ‘Eiko’.

(pf) ‘Baretal’

Syn. of ‘Red Vital’.

(pf) ‘Bareva’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Di Giorgio (pre- 2005), I: Barberet & Blanc. Fls fully double, very pale yellow ground, with broad, very pale pink margins, margins shallowly toothed. Standard. Trade designation: EVA

(pf) ‘Barkassio’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: R. Shemi Ltd, I: Barberet & Blanc (2005). Fls fully double, mid pink self; margins toothed. Standard. Trade designation: KASSIOPELA

(pf) ‘Barmundo’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Di Giorgio (pre- 2005), I: Barberet & Blanc (2005). Fls fully double, red self; margins sharply toothed. Standard. Trade designation: MUNDO

(pf) ‘Barvenus’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc, N: Barberet & Blanc, I: Barberet & Blanc (2005). Fls fully double, deep red-purple self; margins deeply and sharply toothed. Standard. Trade designation: VENUS

(pf) 'Barvera'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: M. Lek & Zonen (pre- 2004). Fls fully double, yellow ground, narrowly edged and with numerous narrow marginal stripes and flecks of red; margins very shallowly toothed. Spray. Syn. 'Lonvera'. Trade designation: VERA

(pf) 'Bawizar'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: M. Baratta (pre- 2001). Fls fully double, white ground, with solid deep purplish pink margin, breaking up basally into very short narrow stripes and with streaks and spots of same colour over some parts of the remainder of the petal; margins very shallowly toothed. Standard. Trade designation: WIZARD

(pf) BELEN Trade designation for 'Barbelen'.

(pf) BELLA LUCE Trade designation for 'Klelace'.

(pf) BERTA Trade description for 'Barberta'.

(pf) 'Bicocca'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: M. Baratta (pre- 2000), I: La Villetta. Fls fully double, pale salmon pink self; margins very shallowly toothed. Standard.

(pf) BLACKY Trade designation for 'Kleblack'.

(pf) 'Boccaccio'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: F. Sapia (pre- 1999), N: F. Sapia. Fls fully double, yellow self; margins moderately toothed. Standard.

(pf) 'Bodega'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 2003), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, yellow ground, with occasional red stripes; margins shortly toothed. Standard.

(pf) BOLERO Trade designation for 'Klen02437'.

(pf) 'Bright Rendez-vous'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: A. Baratta (pre- 1996). Fls fully double, white ground, with peppered edge markings and with occasional long narrow stripes of purplish pink; margins not or very shallowly toothed. Standard.

(pf) BRIO Trade designation for 'Kobrio'.

(pf) BROWN SPRAY Trade designation for 'Kobrospra'.

(pf) BUTTERFLY Trade designation for 'Lonbankir'.

(pf) 'Byron'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Hybrida (pre- 1996), N: Hybrida. Fls fully double, pale yellow ground, with a narrow marginal band of deep purplish red which breaks up into very short stripes on its basal margin, remainder of petal unmarked; margins very shallowly toothed. Standard.

(pf) ‘Calvin’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: M. Baratta (pre- 2004). Fls fully double, lemon yellow ground, broadly edged and flecked scarlet; margins very shallowly toothed. Standard. (Unacceptable name (already in use, Art. 27.1).)

(pf) ‘Camea’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: A. Baratta, I: P. Kooij & Zonen (1999). Fls fully double, mid pink self; margins moderately toothed. Standard.

(pf) ‘Campino’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: A. Baratta (pre- 1997), N: A. Baratta. Fls fully double, white self; margins shallowly toothed. Standard.

(pf) CANDELA Trade designation for ‘Barcandela’.

(pf) CANO Trade designation for ‘Loncano’.

(pf) ‘Cantate’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 1999), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, deep yellow self; margins toothed. Spray. (Unacceptable name (already in use, Art. 27.1).)

(p) ‘Cap Béar’

cv. (Selection from *pyrenaicus*, from a wild population on Cap Béar, Perpignan, France). S: Pépinière Filippi (1999), N: Pépinière Filippi, I: Pépinière Filippi, REG: Pépinière Filippi (2005). Fls single, small, soft rose pink self. Stems 15cm. June-July. Differs from typical plants of this species in its more grey-blue foliage and very compact habit.

(pf) ‘Carducci’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: F. Sapia (pre- 1995), N: F. Sapia. Fls fully double, pale pink self; margins deeply toothed. Standard.

(pf) CARRERA Trade designation for ‘Wescared’.

(p) carthusianorum ‘Rupert’s Pink’

R: Jelitto, N: Jelitto, I: Jelitto (2005). (Derived from hybrids between short forms and large-flowered forms of the species and a variant formerly known as *D. ruprechtii*). Fls single, larger than normal, several in a tight head, intense rosy red; margins toothed. Lvs green. Relatively dwarf, compact habit (20-25cm). June-September. Offered as seed. (Published in Jelitto cat. 2005. The epithet alludes both to the *D. ruprechtii* parent and to Knecht Ruprecht a Germany fairy-tale figure and helper to Santa Klaus.)

(pf) CASABLANCA Trade designation for ‘Klecere’.

(pf) ‘Casper’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: A. Baratta (pre- 1996), N: A. Baratta. Fls fully double, pure white self; margins sharply and deeply toothed. Standard.

(pf) CASTILLO Trade designation for ‘Lonchezu’.

(pf) CELTA Trade designation for ‘Barcelta’.

(pf) CERISE ROSELLA Trade designation for ‘Klesellis’.

(pf) ‘Charmant’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: N. Baratta (pre- 1999), N: N. Baratta. Fls fully double, pale pink self; margins deeply and sharply toothed. Standard. (Unacceptable name (already in use, Art. 27.1).)

(pf) ‘Chateau’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Di Giorgio (pre- 1995), N: Di Giorgio. Fls fully double, deep red self; margins not or very shortly toothed. Spray.

(pf) ‘Cheerio’

cv. (Parentage unknown). H: P. Kooij & Zonen, G: P. Kooij & Zonen (2001), N: P. Kooij & Zonen, I: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, 70-90mm wide, petals wavy-edged, scarlet ground, paling to broad white edges; margins very shallowly toothed; slightly scented. Lvs bluish green. Stems tall. Standard. (Unacceptable name (already in use, Art. 27.1).)

(pf) ‘Cherry Fleurette’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 2003), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, cherry red self; margins not or very shallowly toothed. Spray.

(pf) ‘Cherry Intermezzo’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 2001), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, cherry red ground, shading out to a very pale edge; margins waved and toothed. Spray.

(pf) ‘Cherry Solar’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Di Giorgio (pre- 1997), I: Barberet & Blanc. Fls fully double, deep cherry pink self; margins moderately toothed. Standard.

(pf) ‘Cherry Song’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: R. Shemi Ltd (pre- 2004). Fls single, purplish pink ground, with a broad white margin; margins very shortly toothed. Frisby.

(b) ‘Chesswood Hazel Honey’

cv. (‘Clunie’, open-pollinated). H: D.J. Cottam (2001), G: D.J. Cottam (2002), N: D.J. Cottam (2005), I: D.J. Cottam (2006), REG: D.J. Cottam (2005). Fls fully double, 75mm wide, very light apricot ground, broadly suffused pink at edges and with a few darker ticks; margins entire; slightly scented. Stems c.80-90cm (under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0070305). Etymology: named for the wife of current BNCS treasurer.)

(b) ‘Chesswood Lidgett’

cv. (‘Leon Tautz’, open-pollinated). H: D.J. Cottam, G: D.J. Cottam (1999), N: D.J. Cottam (2005), I: D.J. Cottam (2005), REG: D.J. Cottam (2005). Fls fully double, 75mm wide, pure white ground, narrowly edged and with stripes and ticking of deep red mostly concentrated along centre line of each petal;

margins entire to very shallowly toothed; faintly scented. Lvs glaucous green. Stems c.85-90cm (under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0070310). Etymology: named after the registrant's local area.)

(b) 'Chesswood Phil Dalby'

cv. ('Leon Tautz', open-pollinated). H: D.J. Cottam (2001), G: D.J. Cottam (2002), N: D.J. Cottam (2003), I: D.J. Cottam, REG: D.J. Cottam (2005). Fls fully double, 80mm wide, ground white, edged and lightly ticked pink; margins entire; not scented. Stems 90cm (under glass). Fls with a high crown and rounded form, the petals opening out more-or-less flat (not waved). AM 2005. (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0070303). (Etymology: the amount of colour suggests 'a volcano in full flow'.)

Stems 20-22cm (in the open). (First propagated (2002): Allwoods. Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060680). First published in Allwoods 2004 mail order catalogue.)

(p) ‘Summerfield Emma Louise’

cv. (Parentage unknown: seedling). H: Allwoods, G: Allwoods (1998), N: Allwoods (2000), I: Allwoods (2000), REG: Allwoods (2005). Fls fully double (with a closed centre), ground soft lavender pink, with a suffusion of rose pink towards the centre; margins toothed; scented. Compact habit. Long flowering period. Stems 20cm (in the open). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060681).)

Fls single, white ground changing with age to pink, with a dark eye; margins lacinate; strongly scented. (Raised from open-pollinated seed collected at Cally Gardens; seed parent originally collected in Tatra Mountains.)

(p) ‘Tatra Ghost’

cv. (*superbus* subsp. *alpestris*, open-pollinated). G: Cally Gardens, N: M. Wickenden, I: M. Wickenden, REG: M. Wickenden (2005). Fls single, white ground with a network of pink veins that fade away with age; margins lacinate; strongly scented. (Raised from open-pollinated seed collected at Cally Gardens; seed parent originally collected in Tatra Mountains.)

(pf) ‘Tauro’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: Barberet & Blanc (pre- 2004), N: Barberet & Blanc. Fls fully double, red self; margins sharply and moderately toothed. Standard.

(pf) ‘Terracotta’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 2000), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, pale greenish yellow ground, irregularly suffused pink; margins very shortly toothed. Standard. (Unacceptable name (already in use, Art. 27.1).)

(pf) ‘Terranova’

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 1999), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, soft apricot ground, with an occasional reddish marking; margins shortly toothed. Standard.

(p) ‘Tony’s Doris’

cv. (‘Marina Johnson’, open-pollinated). H: A.J. Derrick (2002), G: A.J. Derrick, N: A.J. Derrick (2004), I: A.J. Derrick (2004), REG: A.J. Derrick (2005). Fls double (but with an open centre), 25mm wide, salmon pink ground, with a red eye; margins shortly toothed; not scented. Lvs narrow. Short stems (to 25cm

under glass). (Nomenclatural standard: colour print provided by registrant (WSY 0060683). Etymology: derived from raiser's christian name and the flower's similarity to the well-known pink 'Doris'.)

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: A. Baratta (pre- 1999), N: A. Baratta. Fls fully double, white ground edged and with numerous, short, very narrow marginal stripes and a few flecks of pinkish red; margins not or very shortly toothed. Standard.

(pf) WIZARD Trade designation for 'Bawizar'.

(p,a) 'Woodfall'

(p) 'WP05 Yves'

cv. (Sport from 'Devon Yolande'). N: Whetman Pinks Ltd (2003), I: Whetman Pinks Ltd (2005), REG: Whetman Pinks Ltd (2005). Fls fully double, 20mm wide, ground white, with a red-purple eye; margins toothed; scented. Lvs grey-green, very compact. Stems 25cm (under glass). Trade designation: COCONUT SUNDÆ. (First propagated (2002): Whetman Pinks Ltd.)

(pf) 'Yellow Liberty'

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: A. Baratta (pre- 1998). Fls fully double, bright yellow self; margins very shallowly toothed. Standard.

cv. (Parentage unknown). R: P. Kooij & Zonen (pre- 1996), N: P. Kooij & Zonen. Fls fully double, pale yellow ground, heavily edged and with very occasional flecks of pinkish red; margins shortly toothed. Standard.
