

Late flowering daylilies which are less susceptible to *Hemerocallis* gall midge

This list was compiled from observations on the extensive *Hemerocallis* collection at RHS Garden Wisley, it is of late-flowering cultivars that partly or wholly miss the egg-laying period of the gall midge. This is not an exhaustive list and there are may be other late flowering cultivars on which observations have not been made.
