





1.		Four trees or shrubs of different genera in bloom, other than a camellia, magnolia or rhododendron, one vase of each.
2.		Four ornamental plants of different genera, in bloom, including bulbs but excluding trees and/or shrubs, one vase of each.
3.		A tree or shrub, in bloom, other than a camellia, magnolia or rhododendron, one vase.
4.		A <i>Prunus</i> in bloom, one vase.
5.		A <i>Pieris</i> in bloom, one vase.
6.		A tree or shrub shown for its spring foliage, excluding conifers, one vase.
7.		A tree or shrub shown for its variegated foliage, excluding conifers, one vase.
8.		A heather in bloom, one vase.
9.		A conifer shown for its foliage, one vase.
10.		A conifer shown for its cones (male or female, including berry-like cones), one vase.
11.		A hardy herbaceous plant other than a bulb, in bloom, one vase.
12.		Any tree or shrub other than a camellia or rhododendron grown under glass, in bloom, one vase.
13.		A pot, pan or vase of bulbs grown under glass or otherwise, in bloom.
Section B		
14.		Any species, hybrid or cultivar, excluding <i>M. kobus</i> , <i>M. salicifolia</i> , <i>M. stellata</i> or <i>M. × loebneri</i> species or hybrids, one vase.
15.		Any species, hybrid or cultivar, excluding <i>M. kobus</i> , <i>M. salicifolia</i> , <i>M. stellata</i> or <i>M. × loebneri</i> species or hybrids, one spray.
16.		Any species, hybrid or cultivar, excluding <i>M. kobus</i> , <i>M. salicifolia</i> , <i>M. stellata</i> or <i>M. × loebneri</i> species or hybrids, one bloom.
17.		Any three different species, hybrids or cultivars, one single bloom of each in three vases.
18.		Any <i>M. kobus</i> , <i>M. salicifolia</i> , <i>M. stellata</i> or <i>M. × loebneri</i> , species or hybrid, one spray.
19.		Any <i>M. kobus</i> , <i>M. salicifolia</i> , <i>M. stellata</i> or <i>M. × loebneri</i> , species or hybrid, one bloom.
20.		Any magnolia, one bloom, shown by a first-time exhibitor or any exhibitor who has not won a prize in the last five years at a previous RHS Spring Ornamental Plant Competition.
21.		An informal arrangement in a vase, urn or basket of foliage and garden flowers, including rhododendrons, camellias and magnolias from the garden of the competitor to demonstrate the colourful arrival of Spring, not exceeding 30" high, 30" wide and 30" deep.
